

2018-2019 Description of Ministries at Cathedral Parish

- **Altar Server** – We are seeking altar servers to assist Father at the altar during Mass. Training will be offered, beginning in 4th grade, with refreshers from time to time. We are also seeking adults to serve at weekday Masses and funerals.
- **Church Cleaner** – Be a part of a team that provides general cleaning to the church, gathering space, altar, sacristy, kitchen, etc. along with special tasks for specific liturgical seasons to provide an organized clean, welcome environment for all.
- **Communion Distributor*** - Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion assist in distributing the Body and Blood of Christ during Mass. Prior formation is included.
- **Council Membership** – Are you interested in being a member of one of our Advisory Councils? ie. School, Parish, Finance, Safety Concerns, Technology, etc.
- **Environment & Art** – We are looking for extra hands to help us to decorate our Parish for the different liturgical seasons. ie. Christmas, Easter, etc.
- **Eucharistic Adorer** – Spend an hour with the Lord! There are open hours for Adoration which include: Wednesdays at 3:00 pm; Fridays at 1:00pm & 3:00 pm; Saturdays at 3:00 pm & 8:00 pm; Sundays at 2:00 pm. We are always in need of substitutes.
- **Funeral Lunch** – A very important ministry of our Parish is providing for families who have lost a loved one. We are seeking individuals who are willing to be a part of a group that serves a meal for the family after the funeral.
- **Greeter** – We would love to have your welcoming faces be the first encounter for our Parishioners and visitors prior to Mass. Let us know if you are willing to be a Greeter at one of our weekend Masses.
- **Hospital, Villa & Home Visitor*** – This ministry extends the love of Christ to those who are unable to attend Mass with us on the weekends by bringing Communion to the homebound, hospitalized, and those in our nursing homes.
- **Lector/Commentator** – Proclaiming the Word of God with clarity and a worthy witness of life is a powerful way to share your gifts with the Parish. We are seeking readers and commentators to assist at our weekend liturgies and Holy Days.
- **Music** – Be a part of the team that supports the sung prayer of the worshipping assembly, either individually or as a member of a choir or ensemble. Ongoing formation is included.
- **Sacristan*** – We are seeking leaders who are willing to set up for Mass and check-in/recruit other ministers on weekends and/or during the week. Training and mentors will be provided.
- **Sunday Coffee** – Be a part of the crew that assists in setting up and serving refreshments during after-Mass fellowship on Sundays.
- **Usher** – Be a part of the team of helpful hands and feet that assist before, during, and after Mass. Prior formation is included.
- **Youth Ministry** – Help support the ministry to the youth of our Parish: ie. Helping to coordinate the activities after our Teen Mass, small group leader for Religious Education, providing food etc. You will be contacted by Hope Bach to talk about these opportunities and how best to enter into them.
